7 Community Garden Progress:

All good. There is a surplus of tomatoes, potatoes need digging out. Scotch Bonnet chillies are thriving, as are the apples. A fruit net and cage are still needed for next year.

Manure/compost Johanna to be looked at for use (should be well rotted by now).

8 Home Improvements:

No 15 (Barry) has had an electrical safety test (it's first in 18 years) and the consumer unit was replaced. A splash proof light has been fitted in the bathroom. Two smoke / carbon monoxide detectors have been fitted (with a remote control).

No 12 (Fred) still has the overflow running and Malcolm is to speak to Fred again about getting this fixed.

9 Any other business:

Greenhouses and beds – Marion suggested a revised division of labour with each being responsible for a grobag and a bed.

The garden paths are cracking and flaking and the surface is already wearing badly (after just four years)

The garden gate (to the actual plot – not the public front gate – which has been repaired) needs the post removing and the water main (part of the garden installation – not a public main) repairing and the post replacing clear of the pipework. This was damaged during the fencing works. The water is kept turned off or there is a leak.
